1 PHILOSOPHY

The TTQ Board supports individuals selected to represent Queensland in recognised table tennis events, for the purposes of creating pathways for participants, improving the profile of table tennis as a sport and becoming the leading state in terms of player competitiveness.

2 TEAM STAFF

2.1 TTQ will cover the following costs for all appointed team staff:

- Return flights to the championships, including regional flights where required
- Accommodation with the team during the championships
- Daily allowance (\$40 per day)
- Closing Ceremony attendance
- Ground travel during the championships
- One State Team Shirt where required

2.2 Team Manager/Head Coach in the AWD, Senior and Youth Teams will receive a payment of \$500 for coaching services upon submission of a tax invoice to the TTQ Office.

Team Manager/Head Coach in the Junior Team will receive payment of \$650 for coaching services upon submission of a tax invoice to the TTQ Office

Assistant Team Manager/Coach in the Junior Team will receive payment of \$400 for coaching services upon submission of a tax invoice to the TTQ Office

2.3 Any other staff members will not receive payment of any kind, over and above the provisions of section 2.1.

2.4 Team Staff with the State Veterans Team will receive no payment other than a refund of expenses occurred in fulfilling their role.

3 ATHLETES WITH A DISABILITY TEAM MEMBERS

3.1 TTQ will supply one free team playing shirt for first time Queensland team members.

3.2 TTQ will pay all team entry fees, including those of President's Team players.

3.3 All other costs to attend the championships will be the responsibility of the players.

3.4 All team members to pay a team management fee of \$20 (maximum \$40 per family).

4 JUNIOR TEAM MEMBERS

- 4.1 TTQ will cover the costs of all team coaching staff.
- 4.2 TTQ will supply free of charge one team playing shirt per year to members of each named team.
- 4.3 TTQ will pay all 'A' team entry fees, including those of President's Team players who do not have an 'A' team in their age group.

'B' team and additional President's team players will pay an equal share of their relevant team fees.
- 4.4 All other costs to attend the championships will be the responsibility of the players.
- 4.5 All team members to pay a team management fee of \$20 (maximum \$40 per family).

5 SENIOR AND YOUTH TEAM MEMBERS

- 5.1 TTQ will supply one free team playing shirt for first time Queensland team members.
- 5.2 TTQ will pay all 'A' team entry fees, including those of President's Team players who do not have an 'A' team in their age group.

'B' team and additional President's team players will pay an equal share of their relevant team fees.
- 5.3 An amount of \$5,000 will be allocated towards the QLD Senior and Youth team members. This amount will be distributed evenly between all team members regardless of their team selection (A or B teams or Presidents nominations). This subsidy is subject to the written head coach report. A maximum of \$500 per player will be allocated.
- 5.4 All other costs to attend the championships will be the responsibility of the players.
- 5.5 All team members to pay a team management fee of \$20 (maximum \$40 per family).

6 VETERAN TEAM MEMBERS

- 6.1 TTQ will supply one free team playing shirt for first time Queensland team members.
- 6.2 TTQ will pay all 'A' & 'B' team entry fees, including those President's Team players who do not have an 'A' or 'B' team in their age group.

'C' team and additional President's team players will pay their equal share of the relevant team fees.
- 6.3 All other costs to attend the championships will be the responsibility of the players.
- 6.4 All team members to pay a team management fee of \$20 (maximum \$40 per family).

7 INTERNATIONAL PLAYER SUBSIDIES

7.1 Funding may be available through TTQ upon application, for players chosen to represent Australia, if the player has participated at the relevant Queensland Championship event for the year.

The application must be made through the player's club. Any money provided is at the absolute discretion of TTQ and will be capped at \$300 per player per calendar year.
